BRIEF HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE

Sri Addepalli Satyanarayana Murthy Government College, named after its chief donor Sri Addepalli satyanarayana murthy was established in the year 1968. An Education society with its chief donor as its President and Sri Chodesitti Surya Rao the Municipal Chairman as Secretary and Sri B. Venkata Raju Gupta as Treasurer left no stone unturned in brining into reality the dream of having a Degree college in Palakol.

Since its inception the college has been catering the educational needs of Palakol town and scores of neighboring villages providing opportunities to the economically and socially backward classes and there by achieving the aim of social justice.

The college has successfully imparted education to both intermediate and degree courses until 1996 when it was bifurcated setting intermediate classes apart, to bring a separate degree college into existence.
