




ICT BASED TEACHING BY DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMICS

Speaker spoke about opportunities available in public and private sectors.






DISCUSSION ON UNION BUDGET 2023-24 WITH STUDENTS ORGANISED BY DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMICS
