Feedback on curriculum is a regular phenomenon in Sri A. S. N. M Government College as it aids in the quality sustenance and enrichment of the curriculum. The college updates the curriculum periodically by closely adhering to the policies and guidelines issued by the concerned regulatory authorities.

Besides catering to the needs of the students and the demands of the employers, frequent meetings are convened wherein the Management, Controllers of Examinations, Academic Coordinator of Curricular Affairs, IQAC Coordinator and the Heads of the Departments discuss Curriculum Based issues. Structured Feedback on individual courses and the syllabus of respective departments are collected semester wise from Students, Teachers, Employers and Alumni. The collected feedback is analyzed by each department. Based on the stakeholders' suggestions and recommendations, the curriculum is designed, revised and new skill-oriented courses are introduced from time to time in the Board of Studies.

The Draft Syllabus is revised in the Board of Studies and finalized. The suggestions of the University Nominees, the Subject Experts, Industrialists and Alumni are incorporated and the Action Taken Report is presented in the next Board of studies. The curriculum is then approved in the Academic Council and the Governing Body. The Suggestions brought forth by the distinguished members of the Academic Council and the Governing Body are

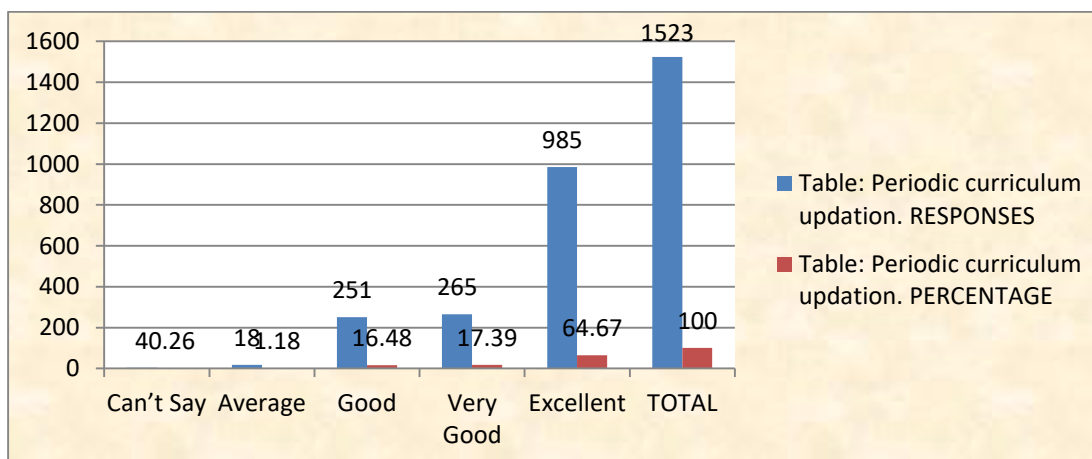
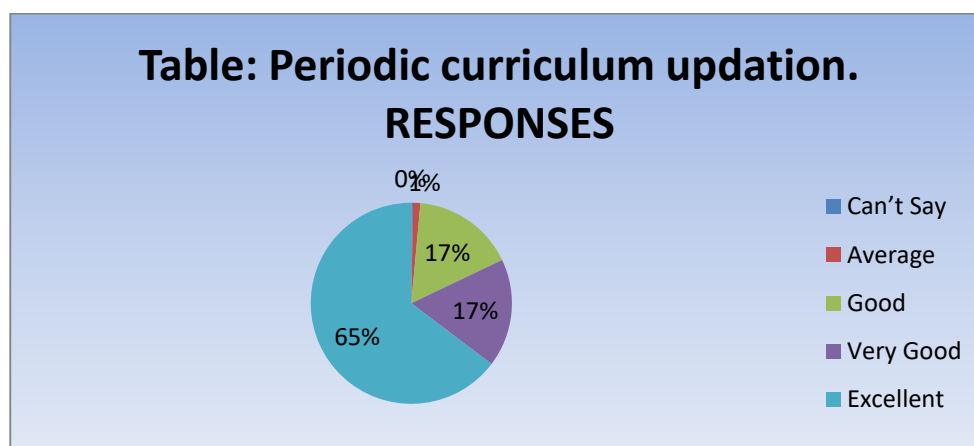
realized and Action taken Report are presented and documented in the minutes of the Subsequent Academic Council and Governing Body.

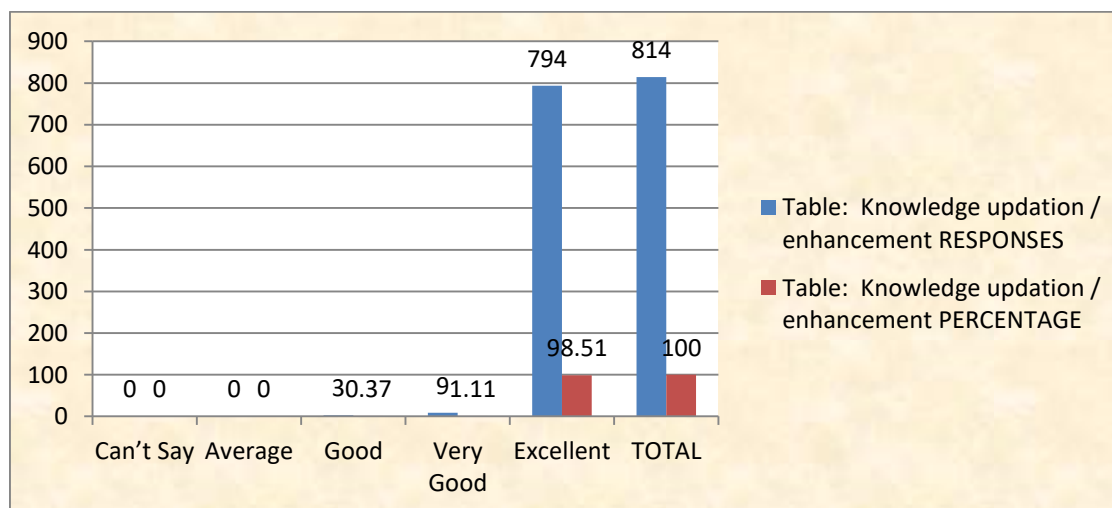
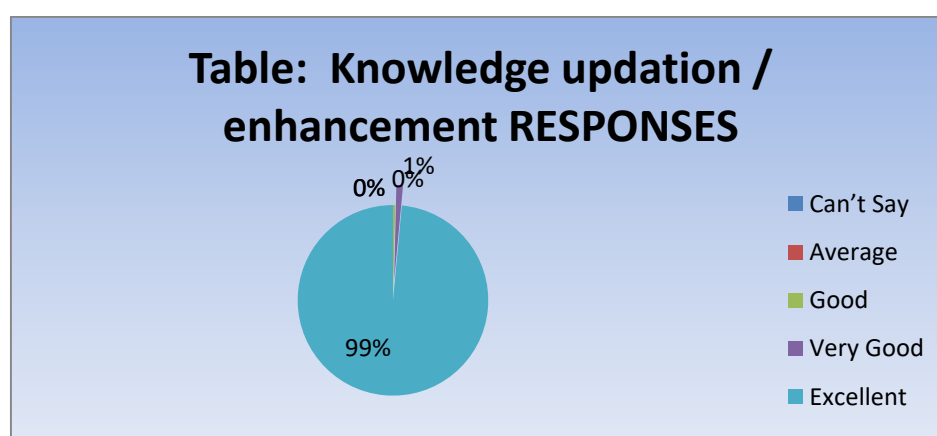
84% of the students they felt happy with Labs/practical experiences and given excellent rating, 15% of students given very good rating, very few of them are not given unsatisfactory.

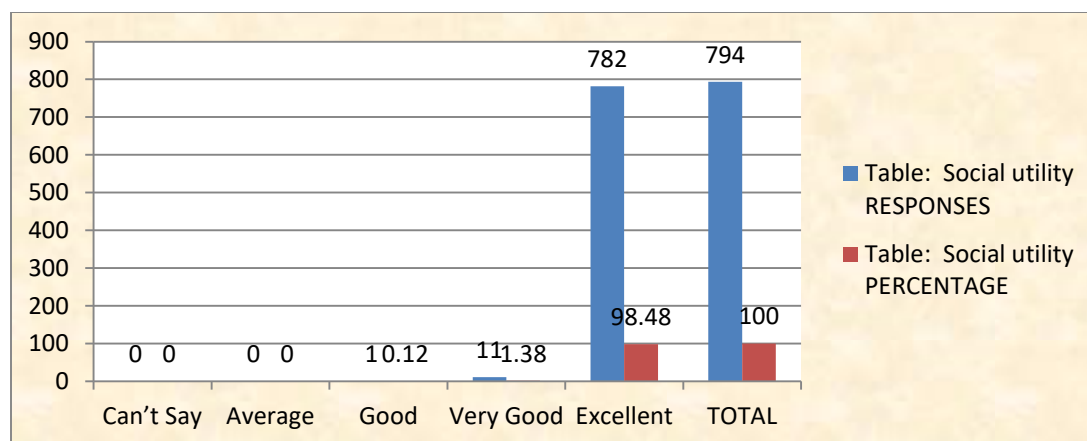
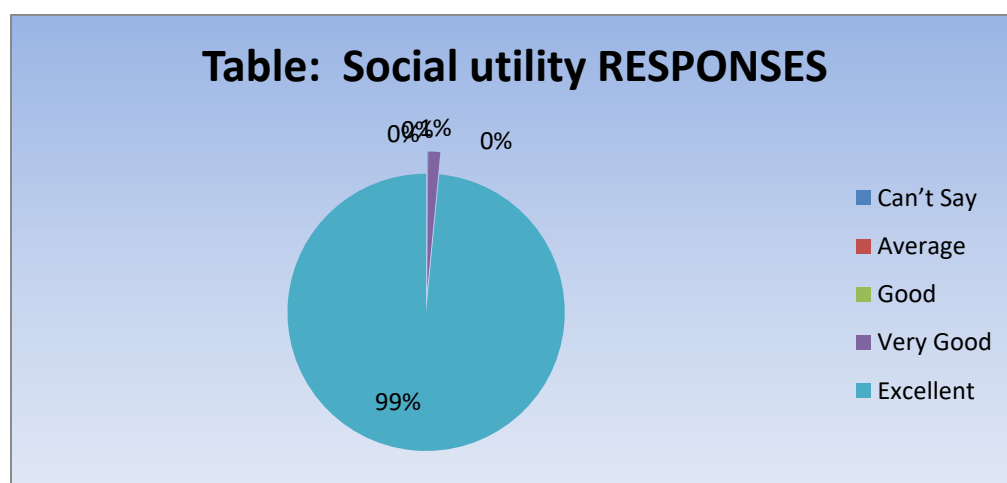
The design of the additional learning inputs are attracted by the students and **97.22 % given excellent** response and no one given dissatisfaction response.

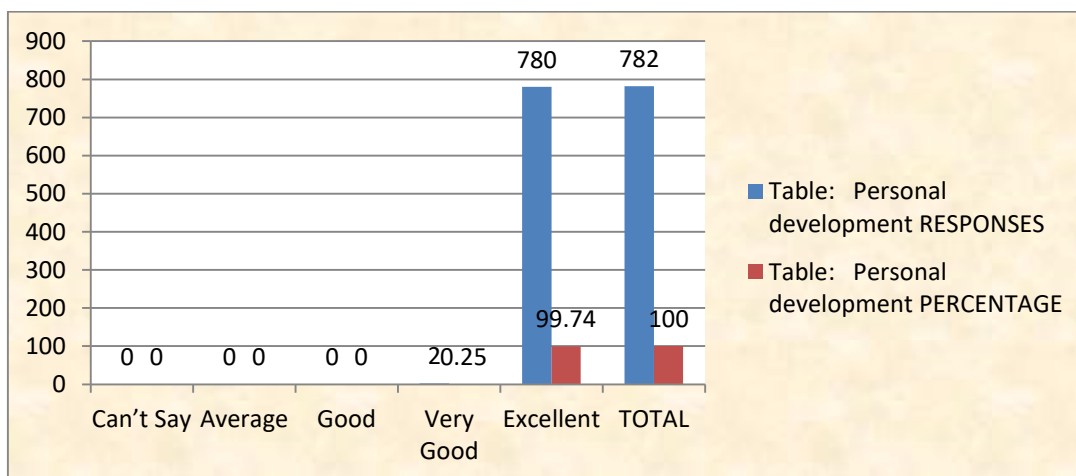
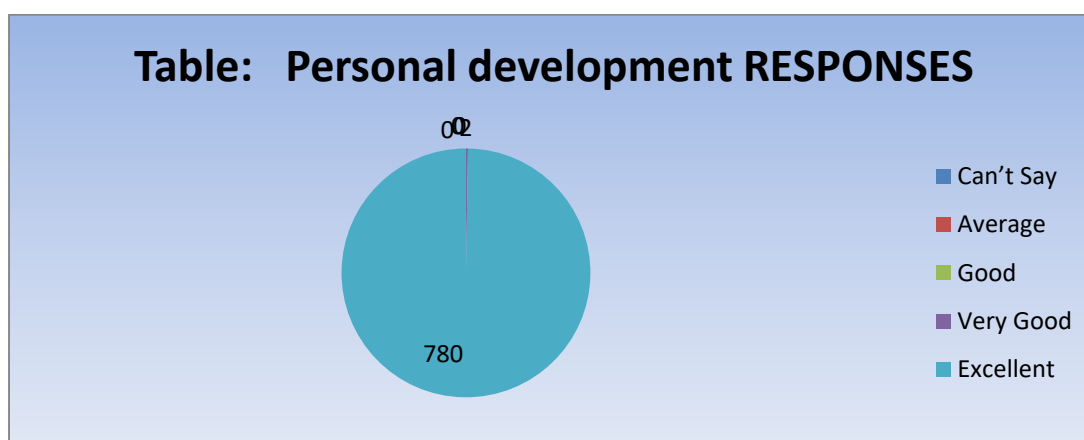
The students have shown so much interest in learning innovative technology skills **98.51% are given as Excellent feedback**. No one given poor response.

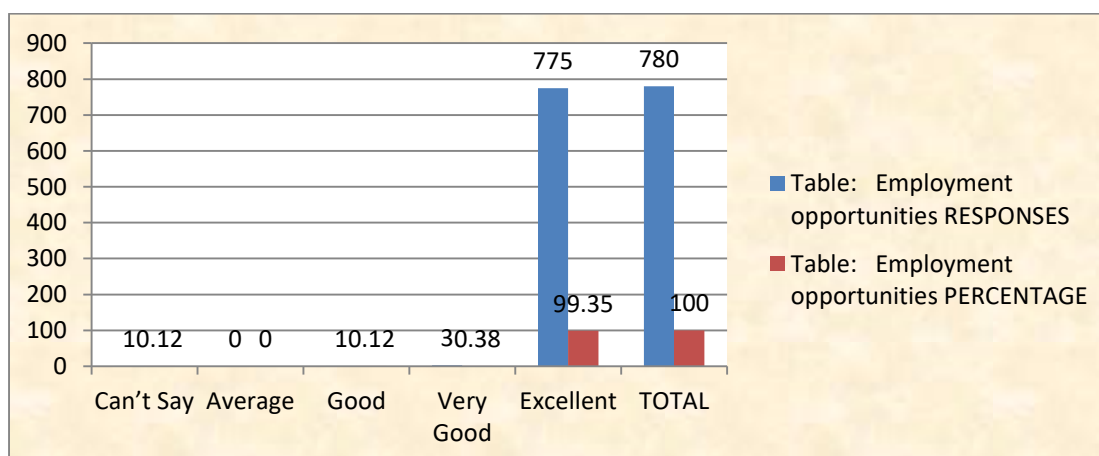
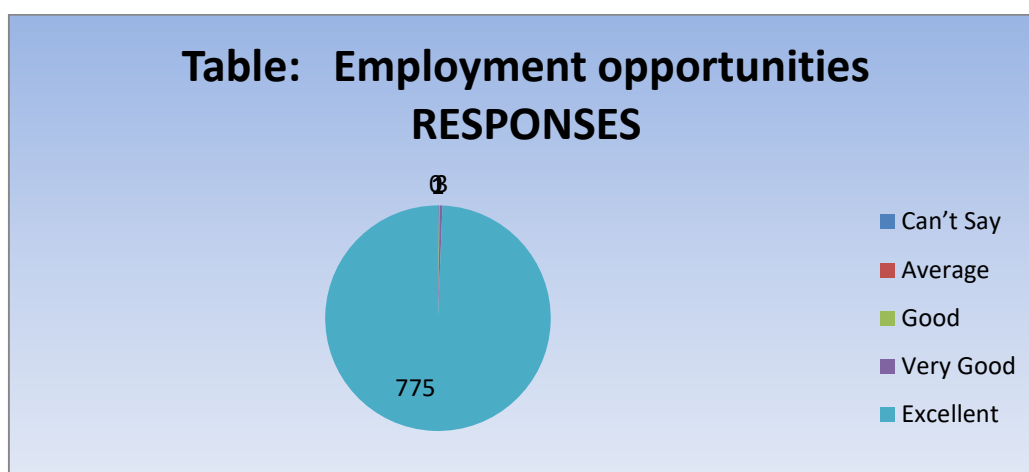
Students have imbibed social utility services to sensitize them opted more than 98% and given excellent response, no one given as poor response.

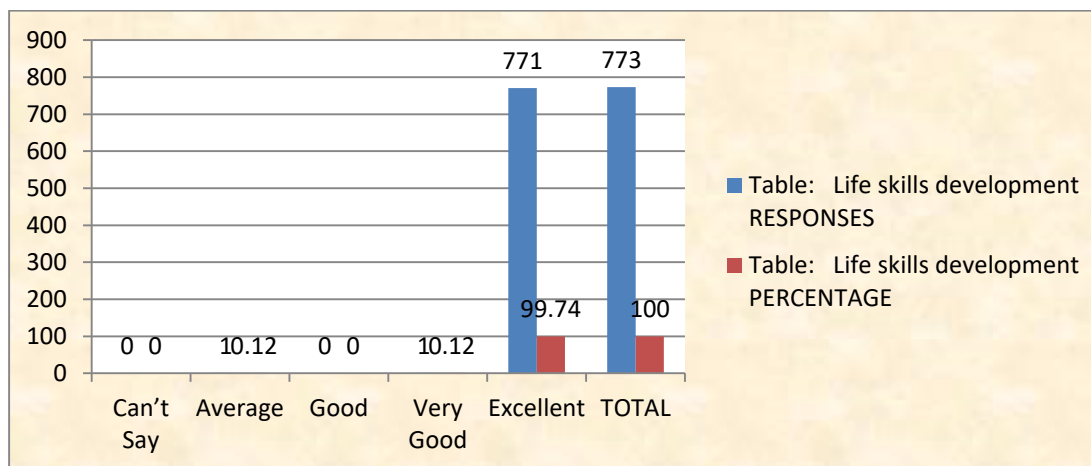
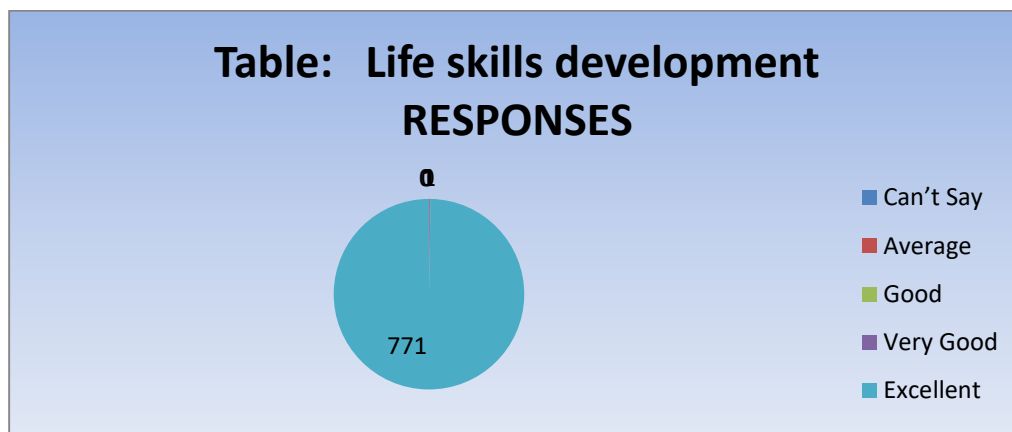
Most of the students are satisfied with opportunities they got through JKC. 99% of students given excellent rating, very few students are given poor response.
