National Service Scheme – Objectives

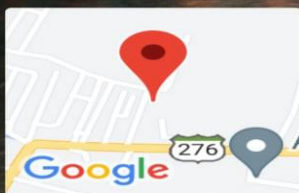
The main objectives of National Service Scheme (NSS) are:

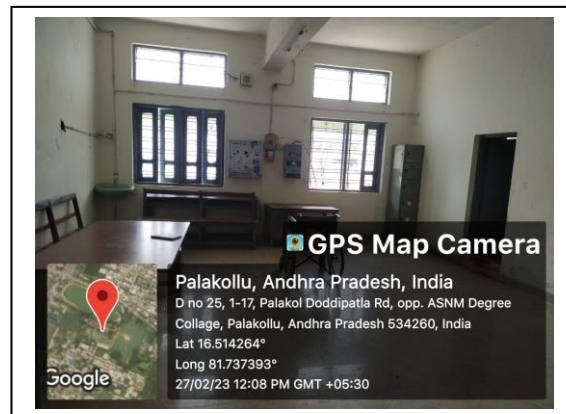
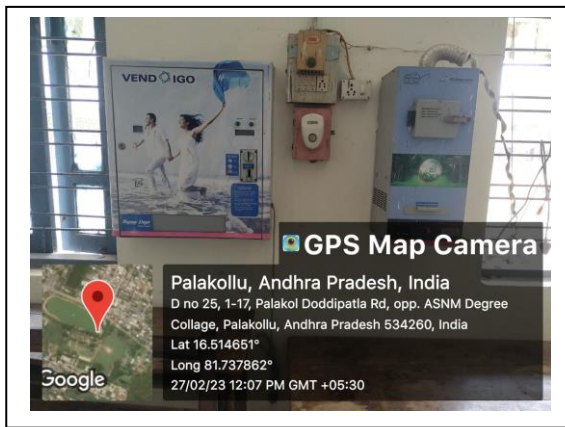
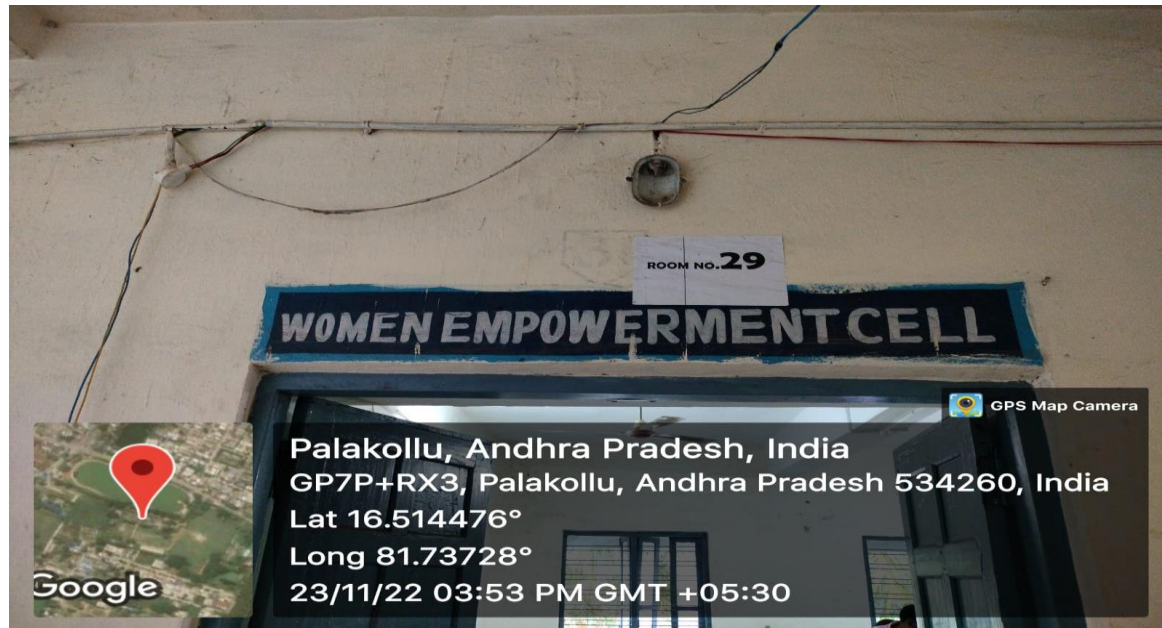
